
HINTS ON HOW TO MAKE PUPPET HAIR WHICH WON'T PULL OFF

The hair on our puppets must not be able to be pulled out by a child, for obvious safety reasons. If you only attach the hair by using a separate piece of yarn to tie the bundle this doesn't hold it, as the hair can still be pulled through. So here are some tips for attaching the hair — if done this way it's impossible to pull it out!

For a male or female puppet

- 1 Make one sheaf of yarn whatever thickness you like and either long or short
- 2 Knot the sheaf on itself in the middle this is the important part, please don't tie up the sheaf with a separate piece of yarn, the yarn needs to be knotted ON ITSELF!



Trim the ends and then attach the knot firmly to the top of the head in the middle. Embroidery thread is the strongest.



Attach the hair at intervals round the head – at this point if using long yarn you could plait it each side and tie firstly with yarn and then with ribbon if desired. For a male puppet without hat, just clip the ends a bit shorter and it looks fine!
